General information:

1. Position: research assistant – chemist, specialisation organic or bioorganic chemistry
2. Term of employment: limited employment contract with the possibility to extension
3. Laboratory: Laboratory of Molecular Virology and Biological Chemistry

Requirements:

1. Education: Master degree in chemistry.
2. Required profile: organic chemistry
3. Professional experience: practical skills and effectiveness in synthetic organic/bioorganic chemistry; experience in chemistry of nucleosides, nucleotides and nucleic acids would be an asset, yet is not compulsory
4. Personal features: ambitious, creative, goal-oriented, responsible, capable of team work, communicative, able to learn continuously.
5. Professional skills: planning and performing multistep organic synthesis, analysis and evaluation of results, good knowledge of English, writing scientific publications, defining equipment demand, computer skills including chemical software, knowledge of computer modelling methods desirable, public presentation of outcomes.

Supervisor: prof. Zbigniew Lesnikowski – Head of the Laboratory of Molecular Virology and Biological Chemistry

Job Description: Synthesis of the nucleosides, nucleotides, oligonucleotides and their conjugates with potential biological activities or applications in bionanotechnology, characteristics of the synthesized compounds, data analysis and description of experiments in Polish and English. Possibility to develop interests in the field of computational methods in the design of drugs, bioinformatics and screening of chemical compounds.

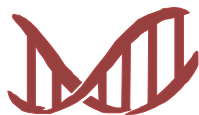
Additional information:

Recruitment procedure will be executed according to the recruitment rules of the Institute of Medical Biology PAS (“Regulamin przeprowadzania konkursu na stanowiska naukowe w Instytucie Biologii Medycznej PAN”) according to the regulations dated May 5th 2011 r.

Required documentation:

Applicants should submit the following documents:

- Curriculum vitae with description of scientific achievements
- Cover letter
- Copy of M.Sc. (or equivalent) diploma



- Please include the following agreement statement: “I hereby give consent to the processing and storage of my personal data included in my job application for the purposes of the recruitment process in accordance with the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 26 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46 / EC”.

Assessment of the applications and publication of the competition outcome.

After preliminary verification and assessment of the documents, the selected candidates shall be invited for interviews, after which a recommended candidate will be chosen.

Recruitment interviews will take place between 12th and 14th September 2018.

In the case of foreign applicants who cannot attend the interview, three letters of recommendation are required from a specialist in the field with PhD degree and Professorial status. Results of the competition will be published on 17th September 2018. Afterwards, the application will be transferred to the Institute HR department for the further processing of the employment procedure.

The Institute reserves the right to contact only applicants selected through verification of the submitted documents and to reject all submitted applications if a competition committee decided that they do not meet the criteria. Please be advised that any documents sent in will not be returned to applicants.
